

Project: The Internet Payphone

Brief: A website that lets you "call" the websites you want to visit.


Result: An interactive payphone UI with a "phone directory" with numbers listed for the client's previous work. Users can call any project listed in the directory and connect to the specified site. Includes: dial tones, custom graffiti based on client's local graffiti artists, and custom stickers.



Project: iPodify

Brief: A website that turns your Spotify into a generation one iPod interface.


Result: An interactive iPod that uses the Spotify API to pull in site visitor's top artists and songs from the past month. Each item on the iPod is clickable and links out to Spotify.



Project: Letterboard

Brief: A website that lets visitors leave messages on a virtual letterboard.


Result: An interactive letterboard where users can generate new letters or move existing letters to write and save messages.



Project: Pi Test

Brief: A minimalist website to test your knowledge of Pi, developed for elementary school kids.

Result: Users begin typing as many digits of Pi as they can. When they get a number wrong, it turns red before prompting them to play again. If they do not wish to play again, they are shown the first 1000 digits of Pi.

Brief: A portfolio site where each navigation item is a marquee, in the style of Ken Kocienda's "Creative Selection" book cover.

Result: A multicolored site of scrolling text.
